## Five questions to help us decide what we should and shouldn't do:

- 1. Does this show \_\_\_\_\_ by helping and building others up? (23-30)
  - A. \_\_\_\_\_ do things that are constructive in others' lives (23-24) (1 Cor 8:1; Rom 15:2; 1 Thes 5:11)
  - B. If someone truly has a problem with it, put them \_\_\_\_\_\_ and don't do it with them. (28-30)

(Rom 14:13, 22; 1 Cor 8:9)

- 4. Does this hinder or help the \_\_\_\_\_? (27, 32-33)
  - Is this about pleasing myself or the sharing the Gospel?
- 5. Am I living in a way that \_\_\_\_\_ Christ and that I'd be ok with others copying? (11:1)

- 2. Can I \_\_\_\_\_\_ this with Jesus? (25-27, 30). (Psalm 24:1; 1 Cor 10:14; Rom 14:5)
  - How does this affect my walk with God?
