- How much does this show Christ's love?
- Praise God for complete forgiveness of sins!

2. Look _____ (26) - Anticipation and hope for the future
(Matt 26:29)

- Think about Christ's return! What are you looking forward to?
- How does this give hope in this fallen world?

3. Look _____ (26) - To a lost world that needs the Gospel

- Think about and pray for those that need Christ.

4. Look _____ (27-28) – Am I right with God?
(1 Cor 5:7; Psa 139:23-24)

- Am I right with God? Any unconfessed sin?
- Is God first in my life?
- Am I living like I appreciate Christ's sacrifice?

5. Look _____ (27-34) - We are eating together
(1 Cor 12:12, 27; Matt 5:23-24)

- How am I going to include others in body life and care for others?
- Do I have tension in a relationship with a brother or sister in Christ?
- Am I holding on to something in the past?
