

ARTICULATING INTELLIGIBLE UTTERANCES FROM THE ORAL CAVITY THAT BUTTRESS THE AMASSING OF THE SAINTS I Corinthians 14:1-25 May 17, 2015

Some purposes of coming together:

1. Edifies: Prophecy is greater than tongues because it _____ others up (1-5)

Tongues (1 Cor. 12:10, 28, 13:1, 14:1-25; Acts 2:5-12) – The ability to speak God's truth in a human language unknown to the speaker or to pray in a language understood only by God or one who is given the gift of interpretation at that time.

Interpretation of Tongues (1 Cor 12:10, 28, 14:1-25) – The ability to understand and make known to the church the message of someone speaking in tongues for the edification of the body.

Prophecy (1 Cor. 11:4-5, 12:10, 28, 14:3; Eph. 4:11; Rom 12:6; Acts 13:1) - The divine enablement to proclaim God's truth to His people with power and clarity in a culturally applicable fashion for strengthening, encouragement, and comfort.

- 2. Understandable: Ministry only builds up if it is _____, and uninterpreted tongues are not. (6-12)

3. Engages: Ideal worship engages both our _____ and our heart. (13-19)

From our statement of faith:

The Gift of Tongues -We believe that the gift of tongues in the New Testament was a "sign" that witnessed to the validity of those bearing new canonical revelation (2 Cor. 12:12; Heb. 2:3-4). Speaking in tongues is not a sign of the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Scripture makes it clear that all believers are baptized with the Spirit (1 Cor. 12:13), but not all speak with tongues (1 Cor. 12:30). The gift of tongues is a lesser gift (1 Cor. 12:8-10; Eph. 4:11-12; Rom. 12:6-8), and, as with all spiritual gifts, the gift of tongues is for the profit of all. If it is not interpreted, it is good only for personal edification. Many of the current manifestations of tongues are human induced, but it is still possible for God to originate speaking in tongues. God is sovereign.
