## **Developing a biblical view of singleness:**

1. Like marriage, Singleness is a good \_\_\_\_\_ from God (6-8) (James 1:17; Matt 7:11; 1 Cor 12)

- 4. Don't waste singleness, it is a God-given \_\_\_\_\_! (32-35)
  - Singleness offers an incredible opportunity to give undivided time, service, and attention to the Lord (32-35)
- 5. The decision to get married is between the individual and God. BOTH ARE AND GOOD! (36-38)

(Is 56:3-5)

(Col 1:10)

- 2. Live for God where you are: Singleness usually has fewer \_\_\_\_\_ in difficult times (25-28)
