Community Groups Sample First Meeting

Purpose: As we have mentioned, the first meeting is primarily a time to cast vision and encourage people to begin to get to know each other. Below is a sample first meeting with some suggested questions.



- Fellowship and getting drinks etc.
- What is community?
 - Possibly show video on community. http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=L6cJj-Ku_e4&feature=player_embedded
 - What struck you about the video?
 - What makes it difficult to build authentic community?
 - O What should we do?
 - o Go over the 4 purposes Outreach, Community, Spiritual Growth, Ministry
- What are some details about our group? (Ground rules)
 - o Respect each other even with differences of opinions
 - o Confidentiality this is a safe place to share
 - o Pray for each other outside of our meeting.
 - o Explain sermon based study. Perhaps give some examples.
 - O What time do you want to start and end?
 - o How do you want to handle snacks? (beginning or end, signups, etc)
 - o Any questions?
- Let's start by getting to know each other
 - o Go around and share what takes most of your time each week. (work, parenting, etc.)
 - Also, possibly have them answer some other "fun" question. Maybe a favorite. Or what was the most impactful thing you did this last summer? Anything will work here.
- Prayer
 - o Allow an open time for prayer requests.
 - Then a time of prayer open to anyone. Please do not force people to pray that may not want to. Encourage people to pick one or two requests to pray for.
- Fellowship
 - As you close, break out the snacks and enjoy time with your brothers and sisters in Christ.
